Our preliminary "Memorandum of Understanding" has been renewed and extended indefinitely. With the funds we raised from our 2013 drive and additional funds from the Boys & Girls Club, we installed theatrical-grade lighting rigs and instruments. We proposed and received permission to rewire our access to sound equipment from the back of the room. And most recently, a beautiful front curtain and main valance has been installed.
